

### **Professor Peter Waddington**

Peter Waddington is Professor of Social Policy at the Policy Research Institute, the University of Wolverhampton.

In the aftermath of the July 2005 London terrorist bombings he was invited to chair the Metropolitan Police Authority's consultation exercise on 'Policing Terror Together' at Central Hall, Westminster. He has also given invited talks at the Labour Party Conference and Police Federation Conference.

Professor Waddington is a founder member of a 13-country academic research collaboration (the International Consortium on Police Use of Force), elected as co-editor of the monograph *Police Talking About Force*, published by Springer in 2008.

He served as Habilitation referee for the Free University of Berlin, and externally examined PhD's at the Universities of Oxford, Surrey, Aberdeen, Plymouth and Glamorgan, as well as the London School of Economics, Queensland University of Technology (Australia) University of New England (Canberra, Australia) and Brunei University. He has given invited papers in Germany, Venezuela, Brazil, Oman, Tasmania, Washington DC, Florida, The Hague, Vancouver, Gothenburg.
